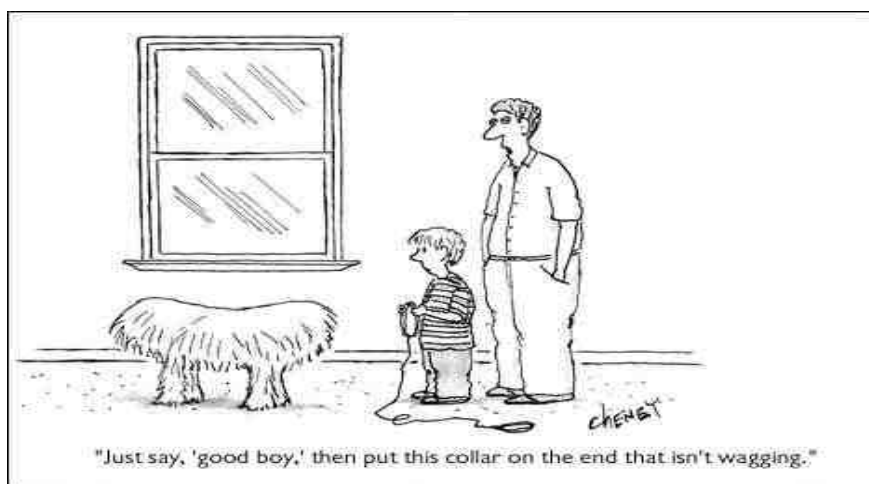

Subject: English as a second language

Having chosen English as the preferred language in the EEC, the European parliament has commissioned a feasibility study in ways of improving efficiency in communications between Government Departments. European officials have often pointed out that English spelling is unnecessarily difficult - for example, cough, plough, rough, through and thorough. What is clearly needed is a phased program of changes to iron out the anomalies. The program would, of course, be administered by a committee staff at top level by participating nations.

In the first year, for example, the committee would suggest using 's', instead of the soft 'c.'" Certainly, sivil servants in all sities would reseive this news with joy. Then the hard 'c', could be replaced with "k" sinse both letters are pronounsed alike. Not only would this klear up konfusion in the minds of the klerikal workers, but typewriters kould be made with one less letter. There would be growing enthusiasm when in the sekond year, it kould be announced that the troublesome "ph" would henseforth be written "f." This would make words like "fotograf" twenty persent shorter in print.

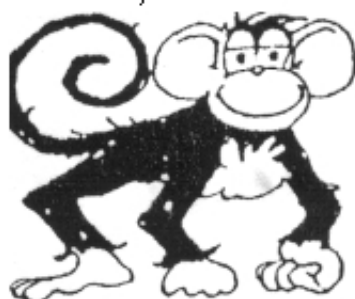

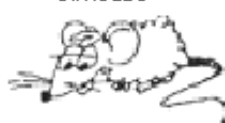

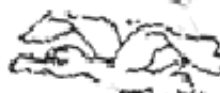
